He advised those intending to return next year to reserve their rooms for 2024 upon checkout. <u>Vice Chairman's Report</u>: (Freddy Allen): Regarding membership, MDC has 59 Chapters with 1734 members. No starter kits are out. There was a slight increase in the number of international chapters and members, but numbers are still low. <u>Secretary's Report</u> (John Weinstein): The Spring 2023 MDC Conference meeting minutes were completed and sent to the State Reps, forwarded on to the Chapter Presidents, and were posted on the website. VA-5 moved to accept the minutes and VA-2 seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> (Keith Johnson): Financial Report – See attached report for full details on deposits, debits, interest, quartermaster sales, etc. As of September 3, 2023, there was \$12,775.18 in the MDC checking account. - 2. <u>2024 Winter Conference Update</u>: Mike Pollinger provided an update on DE-1 hosting at the Atlantic Sands in Rehoboth Beach, DE (9-11 Feb 2024). Costs: registration is \$105 (at this rate until January) and rooms are \$85/night. These rates are good a day before and a day after the event. Mike also encouraged other chapters to host events and assured them there are many experienced conference members who can help.
- 3. <u>Spring 2024 MDC Conference Update</u>: President Ed Martin gave an update on WV-II hosting over Memorial Day Weekend (24-26 May 2024) in Hinton, WV. See the flier at the MDC website.
- 4. <u>Payment of Fees for Appointees</u>: Chairman Chase presented a proposal at the meeting: Starting in 2024, the MDC Treasurer would pay for one conference registration fee annually for each state rep, the chaplain, the safety officer, the webmaster and the sergeant-at-arms. The payments are contingent upon recipients traveling to a conference meeting outside their respective states of residence. The motion was discussed and approved. Keith will provide additional information at the next conference meeting.
- 5. 50. Anniversary (presented by John Bull and Cal Ennals): The 50. anniversary celebration/convention will be held in Sugarloaf Mountain, Maine 21-26 July 2024. The cost of registration is \$225, the high cost of housing and limited supply seems to be an issue. MDC/TSC is exploring the possibility of a joint venture, not yet approved by the MDC, to host a hospitality event. Further discussion on MDC funding was tabled pending receipt of additional information about projected costs.

- 1. <u>MDC 2023 Scholarship</u>: (*John Weinstein Committee Chairman*): Discussed about downward trend of applications and potential changing monetary value. Mike Hart advocated not making changes to monetary distributions since there is no cost if nobody applies. Ronnie Young recommended the guidelines be approved to state the Scholarship Committee has \$1000 to distribute as it sees fit to one or two candidates. Tim Stott also recommended amending the guidelines to state the scholarship could support any posthigh school education, to include vocational training.
- 2. Keith Chase suggested State Reps hold meetings at each MDC conferences. One is being planned at the Winter Conference.

- 3. Cal Ennals announced he'd be selling tickets for the TriState raffle; Ruben Gardiner is selling tickets for KY chapter.
- 4. Pam _____ (Que-1) provided contact information for members wanting to send cards to Guy Poierier, also of Que-1, who was injured in a motorcycle accident. Cards should be sent for him in care of Que-1: 350 St. Pierre #103, Terrebonne, Quebec, Canada J6W5S7.
- 5. <u>Insurance for BK Members</u>: Keith Chase noted the offer members should have received provides \$4,000 free Accidental Death and Dismemberment insurance. There is no need to respond if you do not want to designate a specific beneficiary or review current personal insurance. If you do not respond to the card, the payment will still be made to your estate, not a single person. Specific requirements govern AD&D insurance distribution.
